A low pressure system is moving into the Eights Coast today with its associated front pushing into the peninsula tonight. Winds and cloud will increase late Saturday afternoon and evening with snow beginning around midnight. Winds will drop rapidly Sunday afternoon, with precip decreasing late evening.
