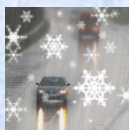

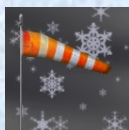
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is moving into the southern peninsula this evening with its associated front bringing increasing winds, rain and snow this afternoon. Winds will decrease Wednesday morning with periods of sleet and snow throughout the day. The next system will bring more wind and snow by early Thursday morning.
