PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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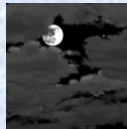
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Gusty winds and snow will continue through today as low pressure moves into the Weddell Sea. High pressure will ridge into the peninsula ending the precipitation overnight, and bringing clearing skies with cooler temperatures for Friday.
