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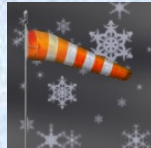
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure systems continue to hammer the Antarctic Peninsula in succession. Blustery conditions and waves of snow with occasional sleet will impact the station through tomorrow.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1/2 – 1 due to snow and sleet

Wind (kts): NE 20-25, gusting to 35

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to snow, becoming 4-6 due to snow

Wind (kts): N 15-25, gusting to 30

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1-3 due to snow

Wind (kts): NE 10-20

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F
