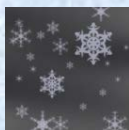
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure in the Bellingshausen will continues to produce northerly winds, with cloudy skies and periods of snow, occasionally mixed with sleet throughout the forecast period.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, lowering 3-5 in Snow, Briefly 1 to 3 in Snow and Sleet.

Wind (kts):) : N-NE 15-25 gusting 35

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -11°C / 12°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted. Occasionally 2 to 4 in Snow.

Wind (kts): N-NE 18-25 gusting 35, backing NW by morning

Min Temp: -3C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 5°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow. Occasionally ½ to 1in Snow

Wind (kts): W-NW15-20 gusting 30, becoming Variable 7-13 by evening

Max Temp: -2C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F
