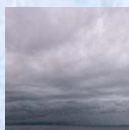
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

Low pressure continues to bring bands of snow mixed with sleet and strong winds to the Station. A wave developing off the SW coast of Chile will deepen and sweep SSE producing another episode of strong winds and mixed precipitation this evening onto midday Friday.
