PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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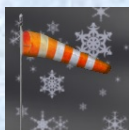
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A period of relatively fair weather comes to an end today as a series of troughs extending from a low center in the Bellingshausen Sea will batter Anvers Island and the Peninsula, bringing stronger winds and snow to Palmer Station through tomorrow.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 2-4 in snow then ½ to 1 late afternoon

Wind (kts): SW 10-15 becoming NW 15-20 gusting 30

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in mixed precipitation intermittently ½ or less in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): NW-N 20-25 gusting 35-40

Min Temp: -6°C / 21°F

Min Wind Chill: -16°C / 3°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in mixed precipitation intermittently ½ or less in snow, blowing snow

Wind (kts): NW-N 20-25 gusting 35-40 becoming SW 30-40, occasional gusts to 50

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -17°C / 1°F
