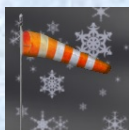
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is nearly stationary in the western Weddell Sea and is expected to remain there into overnight Wednesday. Strong winds will shift southwest early today, with snow continuing into Wednesday evening.
