PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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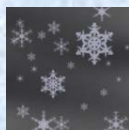
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure in the Amundsen Sea is pushing to the North and low pressure in the Weddell Sea will continue to bring cold air, with cloudy skies and periods of snow to the station. Winds will increase overnight before subsiding tomorrow with snow ending.
