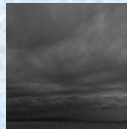
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure continues to approach from the Bellingshausen Sea producing cloudy skies with periods of light snow today. Temperatures will begin to rise today into Sunday evening with snow increasing briefly Sunday afternoon.
