REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Cold with intermittent snow today, tonight, and much of tomorrow – then a low center clobbers the northern peninsula and Anvers Island tomorrow night. Expect winds to increase significantly, but the strong northerly flow means temperatures will rise.
