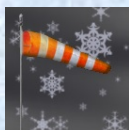
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Cold with intermittent snow today and tonight. Steadier snow much of tomorrow – a low center clobbers the northern peninsula and Anvers Island tonight and tomorrow. Expect winds to increase significantly, but the strong northerly flow means temperatures will rise.
