### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low passes north through the Drake Passage bringing intermittent snow today and tonight with strong gusty winds. Steadier snow tonight and tomorrow as a low forms just west of the northern peninsula and Anvers Island tonight. Expect winds to be strong and gusty throughout the day and evening but to quickly weaken by tomorrow.
