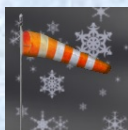
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low moving in from the west will bring intermittent snow starting today with steadier snow tonight and tomorrow. Expect winds to be strong and gusty throughout the day but weaken slightly overnight before picking back up.
