PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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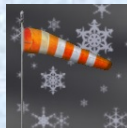
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low continues to spin west of the station in the Bellingshausen Sea bringing light snow and increasing winds throughout the day. A different low pressure system storms in from the north tonight and slams the station with strong winds and heavy snow bringing visibilities down to near zero.
