PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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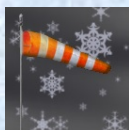
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Multiple waves of low pressure will pass over Anvers Island from the west throughout this period. Expect periods of stronger winds, heavier snow and lower visibility alternating with better conditions during lulls between waves.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-2 in snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): NW 15-20 with occasional gusts to 35

Max Temp: -1°C / 31°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally ½-1 with snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10 becoming N-NE 30-40, occasional gusts to 50 after midnight

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 with snow and blowing snow

Wind (kts): N 20-25 becoming NW 25-35 gusts 40
