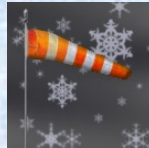
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weather remains gloomy today as Low pressure pulls off to the east, as some light snow/mist remain in the area into this afternoon. Another Low approaches from the west today, bringing the next round of stronger northerly winds and heavier dose of precipitation by midnight, significantly reducing visibility over the area once again. The Low moves east of the Peninsula by noon on Saturday, but the precipitation associated with this system remains over the area until around midnight before conditions greatly improve.

Sky: Cloudy, occasional Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional periods of 3-5 due to snow/mist

Wind (kts): NW-N 15-25 w/ gusts to 35

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted w/ light snow, becoming 1-3 due to snow/blowing snow by midnight

Wind (kts): N 25-45 w/ occasional gusts to 50

Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 due to snow, occasional periods of 5-7

Wind (kts): N 15-25 w/ gusts to 30, becoming W-NW 15-25 w/ gusts to 35

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
