**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

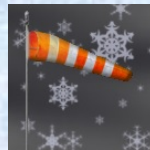
Low pressure will drag itself east across the northern half of the peninsula over the next few days, keeping conditions breezy with extended periods of reduced visibility in snow and fog...
