PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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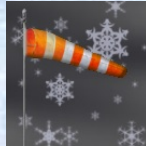
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure moving into the Bellingshausen Sea region this morning will keep a strong northwest-northerly wind component over the region throughout the period, accompanied by a decent amount of precipitation with severely reduced visibilities to boot. The only good news is the temperatures remain on the warmer side throughout as well.
