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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure crashes into Alexander Island well to the south, keeping fairly moist conditions over the area again today. Conditions improve tomorrow throughout the day, but the next Low rolls into the Bellingshausen Sea tomorrow evening, bringing another round of precipitation over the Anvers Island region after midnight on Monday.
