PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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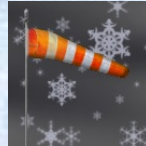
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Fast moving low pressure will approach the peninsula to the south of Palmer Station with the associated frontal boundary hitting around breakfast with increased wind and precipitation. The dinner show will feature the low pressure sliding east into the Weddell Sea bringing another bump in wind and precipitation as a post-frontal trough moves across. Expect continued moist and breezy tomorrow...
