
Wednesday, 15 December 2021 PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

Broad low pressure in the Weddell Sea keeps Palmer area in deep, wet west-southwesterly flow. Expect continued breezy conditions tomorrow with diminishing precipitation as transient high pressure starts to build in from the west.
