REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak High pressure builds in briefly today with skies remaining fairly cloudy, visibility occasionally reduced in light snow/fog and very light winds. The next shot of precipitation works in by morning on Wednesday as Low pressure rolls towards the Bellingshausen Sea region, with a frontal boundary sweeping into the region by mid to late morning, bringing increasing winds and lowering visibility.
