
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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A wet and breezy west-northwesterly flow will remain over the area into Friday as a vigorous Low pressure system crashes into Alexander Island well to the south later tonight, with an associated cold frontal boundary sweeping through the Anvers Island region later today into tonight. Visibility will be up and down throughout the period, with the strongest push of moisture (and lowest visibility) expected this evening into early tomorrow morning.
