REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Merry Christmas Palmer Station! Low pressure continues to hound the northwestern portion of the Peninsula with a moist northwest-northerly flow for today. The next major Low approaches from the west tonight, with a frontal boundary sweeping out ahead of it that begins affecting Anvers Island / Palmer Station after midnight, bringing occasional periods of reduced visibility in a mix of snow/rain/fog into Monday.
