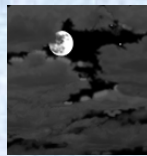
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

If there is “being wrong the right way”, then I succeeded with the previous forecast as the ridge of high pressure sliding east across the peninsula today improved conditions more quickly than anticipated...Low pressure traversing Drake’s Passage will brush the northern tip of the peninsula tonight through tomorrow bringing unusually warm southeasterly winds, unrestricted visibility, and variable high cloudiness...
