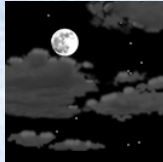
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

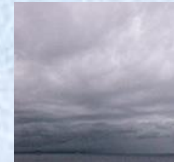
