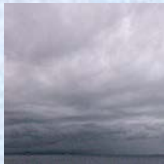

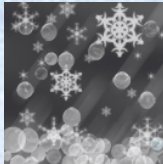
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A cloudy day with light winds transitions to light snow showers and increasing winds overnight. Tomorrow, a warm front extending from a deep low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea moves towards the peninsula causing gusty winds and mixed precipitation.
