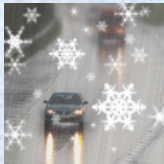
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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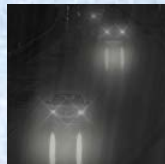
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A warm front approaching the peninsula will cause light mixed precipitation transitioning into heavy rain and increased northwest winds throughout the afternoon. Tomorrow morning, winds and precipitation are expected to taper off, however mist is expected to keep visibility restricted.
