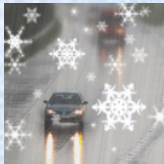

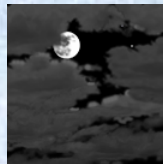
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A shallow wave of low pressure will cross over the peninsula this afternoon triggering mixed precipitation and gusty winds. Overnight, mixed precipitation will taper off and sky conditions will improve, leading to fair weather.

Visibility (SM): 2-5 in rain/snow mix and mist, occasionally ¼ - ½ in rain/snow mix and fog

Wind (kts): SW-W 10-20 gusting 30

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 27°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in rain/snow mix and mist; becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW 10-20; becoming NE-SE 5-15

Min Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Light and variable

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -2°C / 28°F
