Brief reprieve today before the wind starts to ratchet up this afternoon into evening as the next frontal boundary crashes the Peninsula...Temperatures return to the cool side tonight as the deep northwesterly flow off the South Pacific flattens to more westerly...

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 light snow, fog, becoming Unrestricted, occasional 1-3 rain after noon

Wind (kts): NW 20-35, becoming NE 25-40 after noon

Max Temp: 5°C / 41°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-3 rain, becoming ½-2 snow, fog

Wind (kts): NE 30-50, becoming NW 28-45

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½-2 snow, fog, becoming Unrestricted, light snow

Wind (kts): NW 30-50, easing to NW 25-40 after noon; NW 20-30 overnight

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
