PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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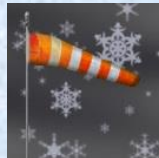
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure crosses the peninsula bringing in strong winds, snow, and reduced visibility for the first half of today. Weak ridging will reduce winds slightly later in the evening and into tomorrow before a trough extending from a strengthening low in the Amundsen Sea slams the peninsula late Sunday evening bringing in another round of inclement weather.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): ½-2 snow, fog, becoming unrestricted with light snow

Wind (kts): NW 30-50, becoming NW 25-40

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-3 with snow and mist

Wind (kts): NW 20-30

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted with occasional light snow, becoming 1-3 with snow

Wind (kts): NW 10-20, becoming 20-30 gusting 45

Max Temp: 3°C / 37°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F
