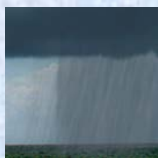
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

In the morning expect moderate rainfall and gusty winds due to a low coming off the Bellingshausen Sea. Winds will taper off overnight, and the rain transitions to rain/snow mix as temperatures fall. Tomorrow, a cold front passes over the peninsula forcing more snow and poor visibilities due to snow and mist.

Visibility (SM): 5-7 in rain; becoming ½ - 3 in rain/snow mix and mist

Wind (kts): NW-N 10-20

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in rain/snow mix; Occasional ¾ -3 in snow and mist

Wind (kts): NW-N 10-15 gusting 20
