REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A weak low pressure system moves across the central peninsula today causing a rain/snow mix in the morning hours. Overnight, the precipitation transitions to snow and the abundance of low level moisture will be favorable for mist, and intermittent periods of dense fog.
