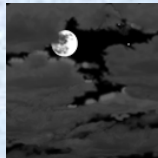
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A weak low pressure system moves across the peninsula encouraging mixed precipitation and mist. Overnight, the precipitation transitions to snow and the abundance of low-level moisture will be favorable for mist. A few snowflakes and breaks in the clouds will be likely tomorrow as lighter winds prevail.
