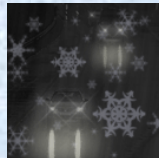
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

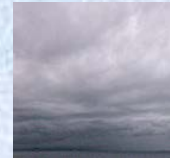
