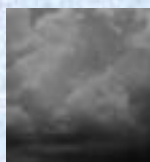
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Mild conditions with early morning fog as a transient ridge of high pressure slides east across the region today. A slow-moving frontal boundary approaches the Peninsula by evening, increasing easterly wind speeds overnight through tomorrow with a good chance of showery precipitation as it passes east...

Sky: Cloudy, occasionally Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 snow, fog, becoming Unrestricted, occasional light snow by evening

Wind (kts): Variable 5, becoming NE 7-12 by evening

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -4°C / 25°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional light snow, rain/snow mixed

Wind (kts): NE-E 12-22, becoming E-SE 12-22 by morning

Min Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy by evening

Visibility (SM): 2-4 snow showers, becoming Unrestricted

Wind (kts): E-SE 12-22, becoming Variable 5 by evening

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F
