PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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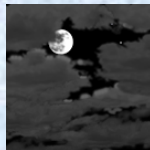
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Shallow low pressure sweeps across the peninsula today providing some brief periods of low visibility in mixed precipitation. Overnight expect improving conditions, but tomorrow a monster storm to the northwest gradually encroaches upon the local area bringing hurricane force wind gusts and heavy precipitation.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 rain/snow, fog, becoming 3-5 rain/snow, fog, occasionally unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW-NE 6-13

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -2°C / 28°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 occasional light snow, fog, becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): NW 5-10

Min Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted becoming ½ -3 in rain/snow mix

Wind (kts): N-NE 10-20 becoming NW-NE 30-40 gusting 70

Max Temp: 2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
