

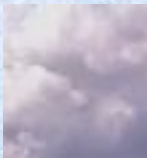

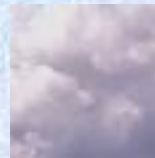

Visibility (SM): 1-3 rain/snow mixed, fog, becoming Unrestricted, rain showers

Wind (kts): NW 12-25, becoming NW-N 7-15

Max Temp: 5°C / 41°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, rain showers, becoming 1-3 rain, rain/snow mixed, fog by morning

Wind (kts): NW-NE 12-25

Min Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -5°C / 23°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 snow, fog, occasionally Unrestricted

Wind (kts): W-NW 18-33

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -9°C / 16°F
