Low pressure slides slowly east across the Peninsula today, and flow will remain moist, flat and westerly under transient high pressure tonight through tomorrow...Cooling temperatures turn precipitation to snow. Expect variable visibility and wind for the forecast period...

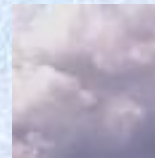

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 1-3 rain, rain/snow mixed, fog, becoming 1-3 snow, fog; occasionally Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** NW 10-15, becoming W-NW 20-35

**Max Temp:** 2°C / 36°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -4°C / 25°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2-4 snow, occasionally Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** W 20-35

**Min Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 snow, fog

**Wind (kts):** W 15-30, easing to W-NW 7-12; increasing overnight NW-NE 20-35

**Max Temp:** 0°C / 32°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -9°C / 16°F
