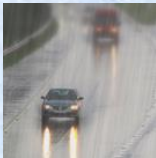

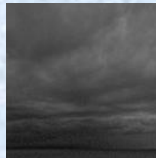
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A trough extending from a low in the Bellingshausen Sea approaches the peninsula strengthening winds with periods of heavy rain and reduced visibility. As the low weakens later today winds will diminish overnight with overcast skies and rain continuing into tomorrow.
