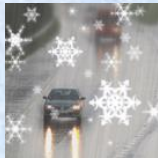

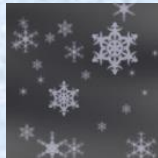
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

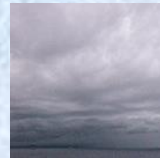
