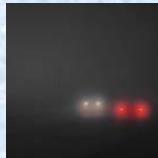
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

After yesterdays blistering frontal passage, today and tonight will see more stable conditions with fog, occasional snow and decreasing winds. Tomorrow, expect better weather with mostly cloudy skies and light winds.

Wind (kts): NW-N 5-15

Wind (kts): E-SE 5-10

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F
