PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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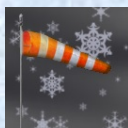
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure continues to dominate the forecast. A low centered in the Bellingshausen Sea will weaken and move SE, with a secondary low approaching Monday evening. Strong north through northeast winds will prevail with periodic bands of snow, occasionally mixed with sleet and rain into Tuesday.
