PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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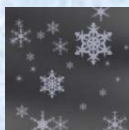
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is ridging over the Palmer Peninsula bringing cooler temps and fair weather. A few lingering showers this morning will give way to lifting clouds this evening. Wednesday will be brighter with winds increasing from the northeast by evening as the next system moves into the Bellingshausen Sea Wednesday evening.
