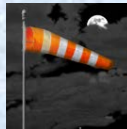
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A front associated with low pressure moving into the Drake Passage will produce snow ending midday as the system finally moves into the Drake Passage. Clouds will lift with some breaks with easterly winds remaining strong into late day Monday.
