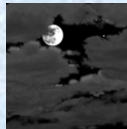
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

High pressure over the region continues bring light winds, cool temperatures, and periods of light snow. The high will begin moving out of the area Friday with light snow increasing after noon as the next front approaches the station.
