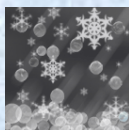
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure will cross the peninsula today bringing strong winds and snow, occasionally mixed with sleet and rain, today. Winds will diminish this evening, with occasionally heavy precipitation continuing through Monday

Sky: Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted. Occasionally 2-4 in Snow and Sleet afternoon

Wind (kts):) : N-NE 15-20 gusting 30. Becoming N-NE 30-40 gusting 50+ midday

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 in Sleet. Becoming 2-4 in Snow mixed with Rain; briefly reduced to ½ to 1 in Snow and Sleet overnight

Wind (kts): N-NW 18-25, with gusts to 30. Becoming WNW 5-10 by morning

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow. Occasionally ½ to 1 in Snow

Wind (kts): WNW 5-10, becoming W 13-18 midday

Max Temp: -3C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -12°C / 10°F
