PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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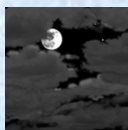
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is crossing the peninsula into the Weddell Sea today, producing variable winds and snow ending this evening. High pressure will move into the region overnight bringing clearing skies, much cooler temperatures and gusty SE winds for Tuesday.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow early. Becoming Unrestricted, occasionally 3-5 in Snow and Sleet

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10 early, becoming SE 10-15 gusting 20 midday

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F

Min Wind Chill: -15°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 3-5 in Snow. Becoming 2-4 in Snow ending mid-evening

Wind (kts): S-E 10-20, with occasional gusts to 30

Min Temp: -11°C / 12°F

Min Wind Chill: -22°C / -8°F

Sky: Partly to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted

Wind (kts): Variable 8-13, becoming SE 25-35 gusting 45 afternoon

Max Temp: -5°C / 23°F

Min Wind Chill: -20°C / -4°F
