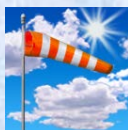
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure building into the Bellingshausen Sea with low pressure in the Weddell Sea is producing strong southerly winds and partly cloudy skies over the station today. Expect a brief lull this afternoon before winds swing from southwest to southeast. Gusty southerly winds will diminish overnight, then swing northeasterly Wednesday afternoon.
